Discussion and Possible Action Re: An application for a Class “B” Fermented Malt Beverage and “Class C” Wine Retailer’s License for Knit and Sip The Sow’s Ear Verona, LLC, d/b/a The Sow’s Ear, 125 South Main Street, Verona, Wisconsin, Jennifer Davis, Agent. The applicant would like to serve beer and wine in the first floor of The Sow’s Ear located at 125 South Main Street. Beer and wine will be served from the café area from 11 a.m. to close. These licenses will only cover the interior first floor of the building (approx. 2,060 sq. ft.). The café seats about 55 people. Premises inspections by the building inspection and fire departments were completed and approved for this property. Motion by Touchett, seconded by Kohl, to recommend to the Common Council to approve a Class “B” Fermented Malt Beverage and “Class C” Wine Retailer’s License for Knit and Sip The Sow’s Ear Verona, LLC, d/b/a The Sow’s Ear, 125 South Main Street, Verona, Wisconsin, Jennifer Davis, Agent. Motion carried 3-0.
