5. Discussion and Possible Action Re: Special event permit application and Temporary Class “B” Fermented Malt Beverage license from Simeon Alder for the Madison 56ers Fall Invitational on Friday, September 9th-Sunday, September 11th

The Madison 56ers will be selling beer at Reddan Soccer Park during their fall invitational. Service will be in plastic cups, the area will be fenced with a single layer, one in/out point, IDs will be checked by club volunteers, and they are requesting an officer onsite to direct traffic.

Motion by Touchett, seconded by seconded by Hoechst to approve a Special event permit application and Temporary Class “B” Fermented Malt Beverage license from Simeon Alder for the Madison 56ers Fall Invitational on Friday, September 9th-Sunday, September 11th, contingent upon receipt of insurance and issuance of an operator license for the event. The cycling portion of the Ironman Wisconsin Race will pass through Verona twice. The first cyclist is expected to pass through the City around 8 a.m. and the last cyclist will pass through around 5:00 p.m. There will be several road closures and multiple officers directing traffic. Electronic sign boards will be placed on Main St. and E. Verona Ave. prior to the race to notify motorists of the race.
