Hi Bruce,

The cemetery is 15.75 acres and is adjacent to the Catholic cemetery. These are separate entities and I do not know the acreage of the Catholic side.

The Verona Cemetery is operated by an association that consists of a President, Secretary/Treasurer and a Board of Trustees.

The cemetery currently has quite a large area that is platted and ready for sale as burial sites. There is also another substantial area that is not platted and to be used for future growth.

I would estimate the platted area would be adequate for at least forty to fifty years and the unplatted portion for another twenty or more years.

The cemetery was established in 1848 and currently has 2291 burials.
