BRUSH

City of Verona residents: Resident curbside brush collection is a year-round city service. Brush is picked up on the 2nd and 4th full weeks of each month, starting on the Monday of that week, and the crew then works their way through the city during the week. The collection guidelines must be followed in order to have your brush picked up:

- Collection is for tree trimmings, stumps, and shrubs. Yardwaste will **NOT** be collected with brush ([See "YARDWASTE"](#))
- Brush that is cut by persons/firms hired by the property owner will **NOT** be collected
- Tree trunks and limbs must have branches trimmed off
- Limbs must be no greater than 8 feet long
- Lay branches parallel to the street in piles no longer than 8' (please limit the number of piles)
- Pile brush neatly; do not put brush inside of cardboard boxes or plastic bags
- Brush needs to be placed in the curb line of the road, away from any obstructions such as light poles or fire hydrants
- Have brush at the curb by 7:00 am Monday morning on the 2nd and 4th Monday of the month

Resident brush may also be taken to the Public Works Drop-off Facility. Proof of residency is required.

CARDBOARD

City of Verona Residents with city service through Waste Management: For pick-up on your regular recycling day, cardboard must be flattened and put INSIDE your cart; Waste Management will no longer pick up cardboard that is out next to the cart. Residents with extra cardboard can bring flattened boxes to the residential cardboard dumpster at the Public Works Drop-off facility at 410 Investment Ct. Proof of residency is required.

METAL

City of Verona residents: Residents may bring metals to the Public Works Drop-off facility at 410 Investment Ct. Anything that is powered by gas or battery must have fuel drained/battery removed. Proof of residency is required. Place in "Metals" bin.

MOTOR OIL

City of Verona residents: Residents may bring waste motor oil to the Public Works Drop-Off site at 410 Investment Ct. Proof of residency required.

*Note: Many oil change service stations, such as Jiffy Lube, Valvoline Instant Oil Change, and other auto shops, accept waste motor oil. Call a location near you to see if they accept waste motor oil.

PAINT – ACRYLIC/LATEX-BASED

*Note: To avoid waste, the Dane County Clean Sweep will accept nearly full, good condition latex paint into their product exchange program

Acrylic and latex-based paints are non-hazardous and soluble in water. These paints will be labeled 'acrylic', 'latex', and have directions that specify to clean up or thin with water. Since this type of paint is non-hazardous, it can be disposed of in your regular trash as long as it is **completely dried/solidified**. To properly solidify latex paint, use one of the following methods:

- Remove lid and let paint dry out in the can in a dry, preferably warm place that is out of reach of children and animals. This method only works if there is an inch of paint or less left in the can.
- Mix paint with the same amount of cat litter, stir completely and let dry.
- Mix paint with latex paint hardener, which can be found at your local hardware store.
- If you have large volume of paint to dispose of, line a larger size cardboard box with a plastic bag. Add an absorbing agent (cat litter, sawdust, shredded newspaper) to the box and pour up to an inch of paint into the box and let harden. Repeat the process until all of the paint is hardened.

Once the paint is solidified, you can throw it out in your regular trash. Do not replace the lid on any paint cans that you throw away.

PAINT – OIL/SOLVENT-BASED

Oil and solvent-based paints are hazardous and combustible. These paints will be labeled ‘oil’, ‘alkyd’, and include directions that specify to clean up or thin with mineral spirits or paint thinner. This type of paint, no matter if it is liquid or solidified, should be taken to the DCCS for proper disposal. DO NOT put these kinds of paint in your regular trash.

YARDWASTE

ie: grass clippings, leaves, weeds, twigs (less than ½" diameter, shorter than 12" long), vegetable/plant matter, hay/straw
City of Verona residents: Residents may put yardwaste out for curbside collection during **OCTOBER & NOVEMBER only**. The collection guidelines must be followed in order to have your yardwaste picked up:

- Leaves need to be in a separate pile from any other yard waste
- Yardwaste piles must be separate from woody plants/brush piles. If combined, neither will be collected.
- Have yard waste at the curb 7:00 am Monday morning on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of October and November.

Resident brush may also be taken to the Public Works Drop-off Facility. Proof of residency is required. Yardwaste must be dumped out of any bags and the bags may be disposed of in the designated receptacle.
